WHAT YOU WILL DO

- Lead on establishing and maintaining curriculum, standards, assessment and reporting in Literacy, within the framework of whole-school policies. Diagnose specific instructional needs.
- Refine and strengthen Elementary School-wide expectations for Reading, Writing (including spelling and grammar), and Oracy appropriate to the level of a school of high calibre academic school.
- Ensure consistency in the explicit teaching of handwriting throughout the Elementary School, including standards of presentation and penmanship.
- Support Elementary School teachers to develop, implement, and reflect on evidence-based instructional practices to embed these proficiencies in their students.
- Teach in classes of Elementary School in support of Literacy for a reduced load of up to 600 minutes per week.
- Be responsible for the collection, management, analysis and reporting of KPIs in Literacy, including academic value-added measures for Elementary School.
- Develop and promote a Literacy ethos that is Bible-centric and that views all teachers as teachers of Literacy.
